

Simulated leather-bound book spines

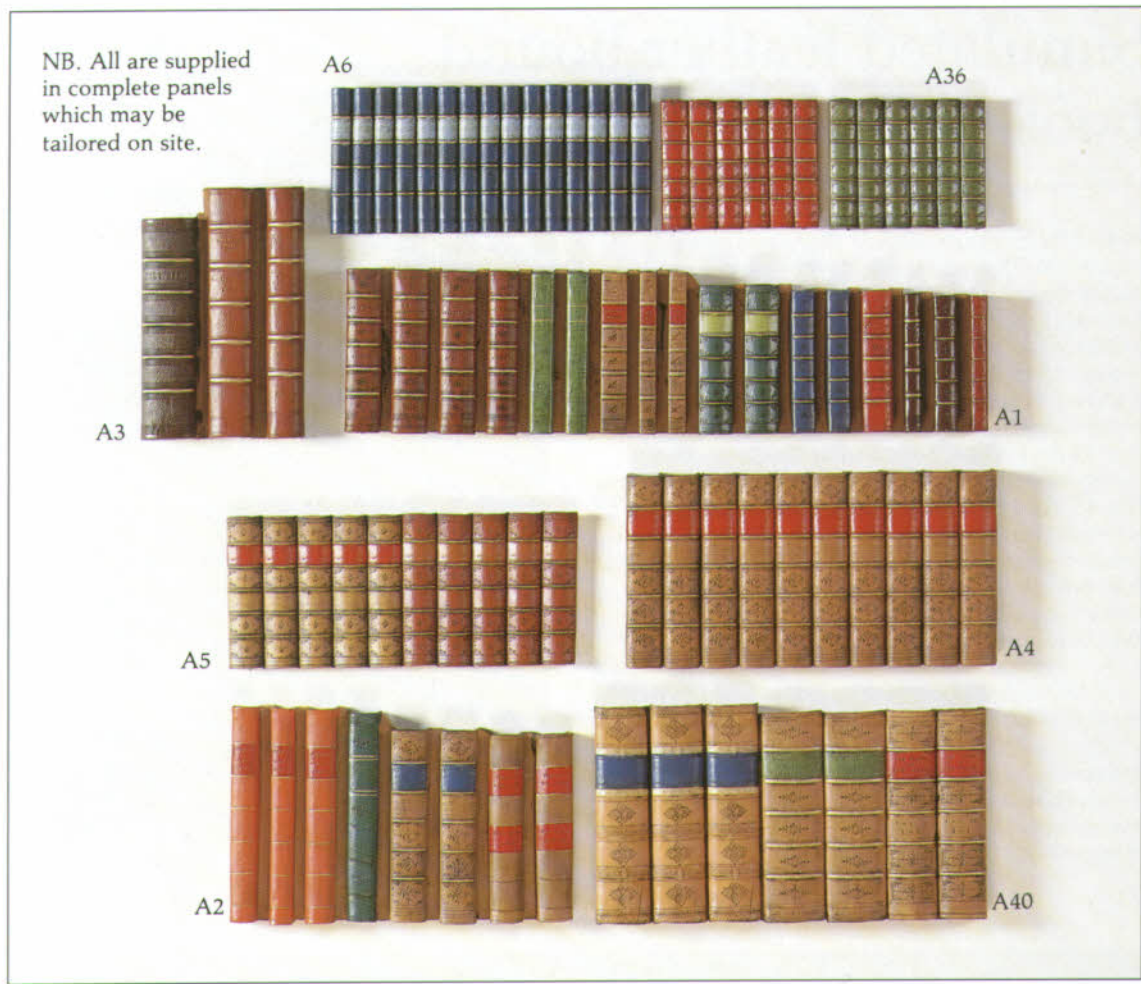


Perfect for furniture display props and hidden cupboards. These mouldings were taken from old leather-bound books of mixed titles, being up to 2in deep featuring the spine only. They are not free standing and when used as a furniture display require propping at the front of the shelves. As cladding they are best glued to a dark-painted background, perhaps on shallow stained timber shelves for realism. Supplied by the panel in a variety of antiqued colours, all painted by hand. The A1, A2 and A3 are manufactured with a gap between each book, so that when separated, paint-finished spine and part of faces are shown, rather than raw foam, visible when the remaining books are cut (see detail). Seek our advice when calculating your requirements.

Care: bookspine panels are supplied in a random mixture of finishes, not necessarily as illustrated overleaf, with a good proportion featuring gilt embossing, raised bands, titles etc. For best results panels should be cut and assembled carefully during installation, to achieve an attractive variety of spines and finishes for realism.

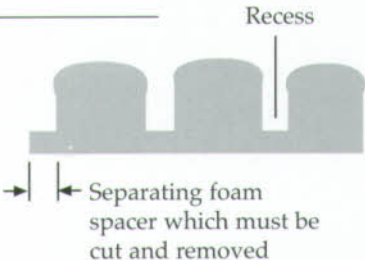
