Popular in the fine houses of the 18th Century, damask fillets were used to enframe silk wallcovering and provide a delicate concealment for joints with cornice, dado, architrave, and adjacent walls. Cast mainly from short pieces of old, carved wood originals, and supplied in gilt or wood finishes, or ready for finishing, the fillets offer enrichment for a variety of situations in need of subtle embellishment.

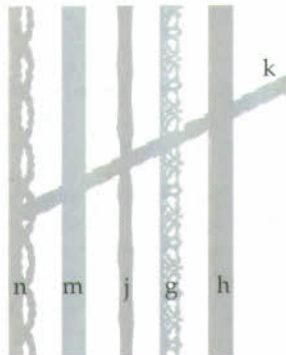
